Pancake Tuesday



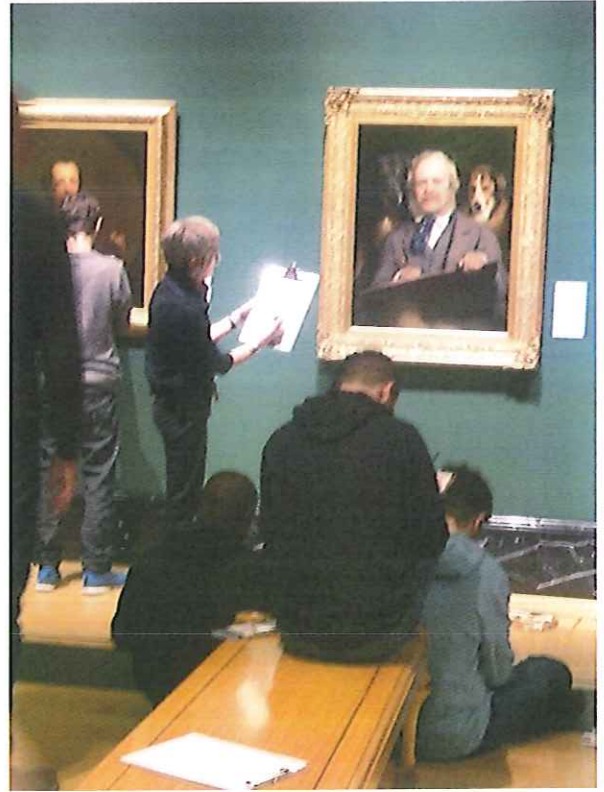

Tower of London

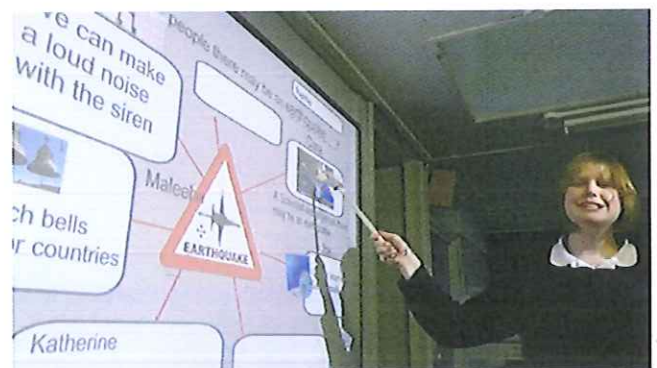
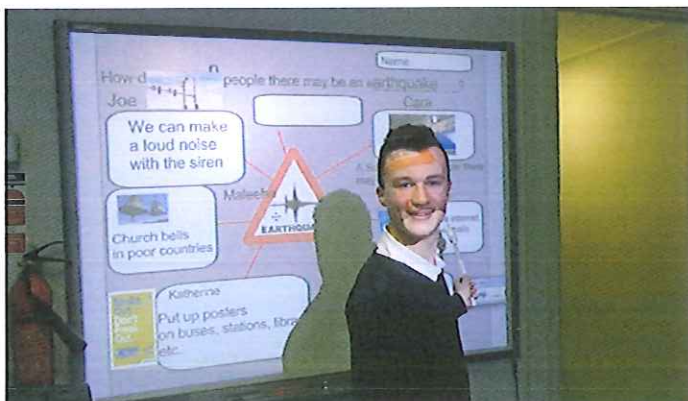
