Students throughout the school have completely 'fallen' for the Peckham family! We learned how the couple stay together while Mrs Peckham lays her egg in the middle of the Antarctic winter in temperatures of -50°C . She passes the egg to Mr Peckham who cares for the egg for two months while Mrs Peckham goes out to sea to fish. When she returns in October, the baby Victoria has hatched and is being cared for and fed by Mr Peckham. But now Mr Peckham is very hungry and leaves Victoria with her mother while he goes away to fish. All the students have loved to hear about the amazing life of an Emperor penguin!
